

#### 2023 Tree Sale Order Form Inside

Rick Kramer has lived on his property in Brainerd, MN for the last 70 years. He built a home on 2.5 acres in 1978 and purchased an adjacent 40 acres ten years later. With the new land purchase, he decided to have a Forest Steward-ship Plan written for his property. Rick and his wife Marsha have been an admirable example of land stewardship ever since. In 1991, they conducted a 40 acre timber harvest followed by planting 4,000 red pine and 1,000 white spruce. In 1997, Rick inherited an additional 32.5 acres from his parents and planted crabapple trees, apple trees, and highbush cranberry. They have kept their Forest Stewardship Plan up to date by renewing it every 10 years.

After the last renewal of their Forest Stewardship Plan in 2018, they followed the advice of their forester to harvest timber off 40 acres to remove diseased trees, blow down, and thin the red pine stand. After the harvest they utilized DNR cost share to plant and protect 1,000 bur oaks, bud cap, and begin the fight to control invasive buckthorn.

In 2022, Rick inquired with Crow Wing SWCD about cost share opportunities for a prescribed grazing project to uti-

lize goats to help manage buckthorn on the property. Crow Wing SWCD staff worked with the Natural Resource Conservation Service and the contractor, Brainerd Lakes Goats, to devise a plan to have a herd of approximately 40 goats grazing 35 acres from May to October. Goats defoliate buckthorn and fully digest berries of the plant; this forces buckthorn to expend energy trying to regenerate leaves and prevents the buckthorn seeds from reaching the soil.

Rick and Marsha were even gracious enough to allow Crow Wing SWCD to highlight the project for the Area VIII SWCD Tour, opening the property to a bus load of people to view the work. This project served as a great educational tool for staff to see the impact and uses of goat grazing (see the difference between grazed and ungrazed paddocks in the headline image). A sentiment that Crow Wing SWCD can echo, Rick stated "I was very impressed with the work the goats did and the commitment of the owner, Joe."
